## how to use the bus

For the best tickets, live times and bus tracking download our app from the App Store and Google Play Store.

Get to the bus stop a few minutes before departure time.

Raise your arm to signal stop as the bus approaches.

Tell our friendly driver which ticket you want, and if you're 16 or over, remember you'll need to show ID to get these discounts.

Buy your ticket in advance on our app or buy on board from the driver. Try to pay with a contactless bank card if you can.

Take a seat, enjoy the ride and press the bell when the bus gets close to where you want to get off.

there's just a few things you'll need to know:




1

If you're 11 or over you'll need to pop a mask or face covering\* on, and wear it throughout your journey.




2

You can sit together if you're in your school bubble or with members of your own family, otherwise please always leave space between yourself and other passengers.

3

If you can, please buy your ticket on the app before you board or have the exact fare. This makes things a lot easier as we are unable to give change.



*\*please note some pupils are exempt*

If you're using our dedicated school services, things are a little different, these buses can run to almost full seated capacity as pupils will be travelling in their bubbles. However it's encouraged that a row of seats is left between year groups. Please remember you still have to wear your face covering if you're 11 or over.

<b>Under 19 Single</b> (bus only)	<b>£1.20</b>	For one off journeys.
<b>5 TO 25 Day</b>	<b>£4.50</b>	If you're making lots of journeys in a day.
<b>5 TO 25 Week</b>	<b>£17</b>	
<b>5 TO 25 Month</b> (app only)	<b>£68</b>	
<b>5 TO 25 Flexi 5</b> (app only)	<b>£17</b>	For flexibility when you need to use your tickets.
<b>Under 19 School Tripper</b> (app only)	<b>£12</b>	For school travel - available to use from 7am and 9am, and 2pm and 5pm Monday to Friday.
<b>Nexus Under 16 POP single</b> (bus only)	<b>60p</b>	Available for journeys in Tyne & Wear for anyone with a valid Nexus Under 16 POP card.
<b>Nexus Under 16 Child All Day CAT Ticket</b> (bus only)	<b>£1.10</b>	The CAT ticket gives unlimited travel on buses, Metro and Shields Ferry within Tyne & Wear.

Our young people's discounts are valid for 5 to 25 year olds, but please don't forget you need to show your ID as well as your ticket if you're 16 or look older.

You can show any of these, CitizenCard, Validate UK with PASS hologram, photographic driving licence or passport, Young Persons 16-25 Railcard, valid local Student ID showing photograph, name and date of birth, Transport ID Cards: Stagecoach VIP, Network One Young Persons ID Card, Arriva Teen Card.

If you're travelling in school uniform or travelling to and from school/college on dedicated services you won't be asked to show ID.
