Metro Cube

Bessie Surtees House

In 1772, Bessie Surtees is said to have ran away with John Scott from her first floor window. They went to Scotland and got married. John Scott then became a lawyer then Lord Chancellor of England



Grey's Monument

This Monument was built in 1838, celebrating the Great Reform Act of 1832, one of Charles Grey's most important achievements, it is one of the most famous sights in the Toon.

Newcastle Black Gate

The Black Gate is the mid 13th century stone gatehouse, founded by King Henry III. Defending the North Gate of Newcastle Castle, it was the last medieval addition.

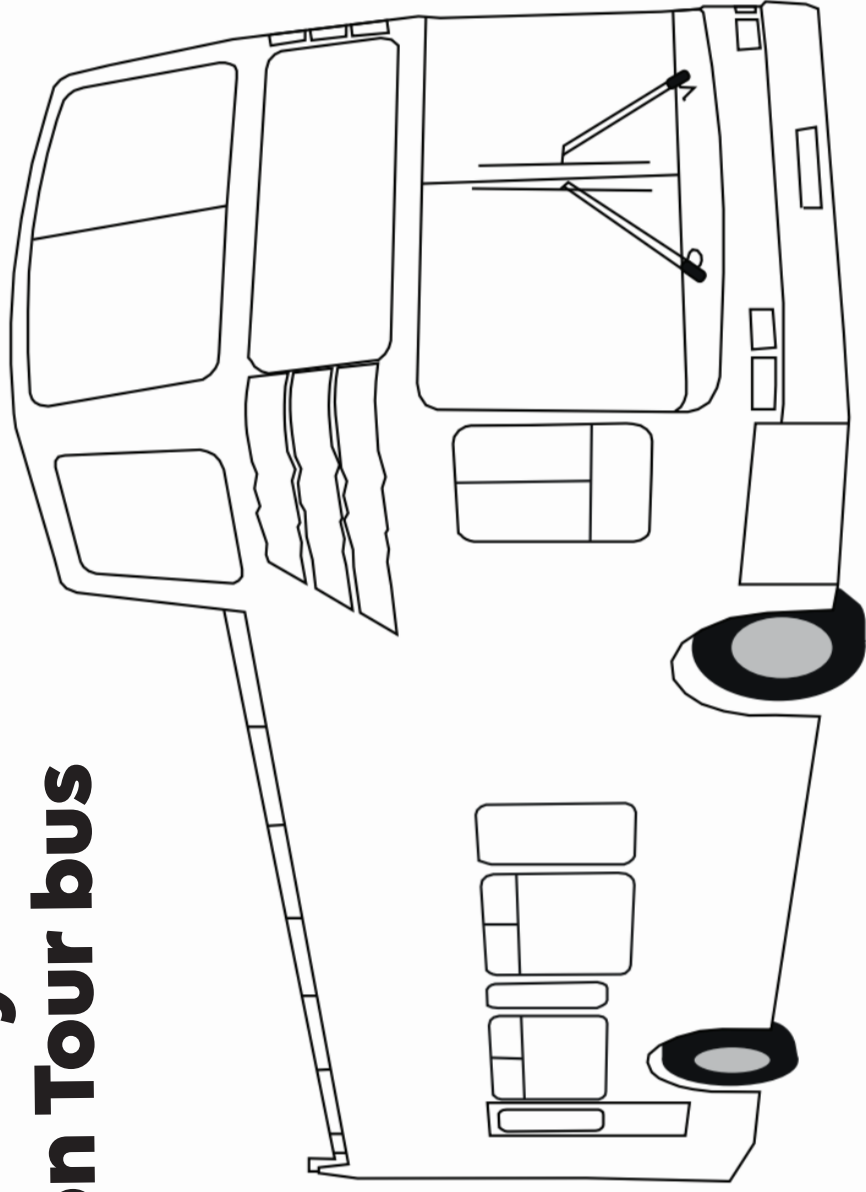


Newcastle Castle

The reason our city was given its name – the New Castle was built between 1172 and 1177 by Robert Curthose on the site of the Roman fort Pons Aelius, which means 'Bridge of Hadrian'. It is visible through the city but you'll have a peek of it as we turn right back towards Central Station!

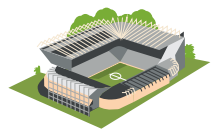
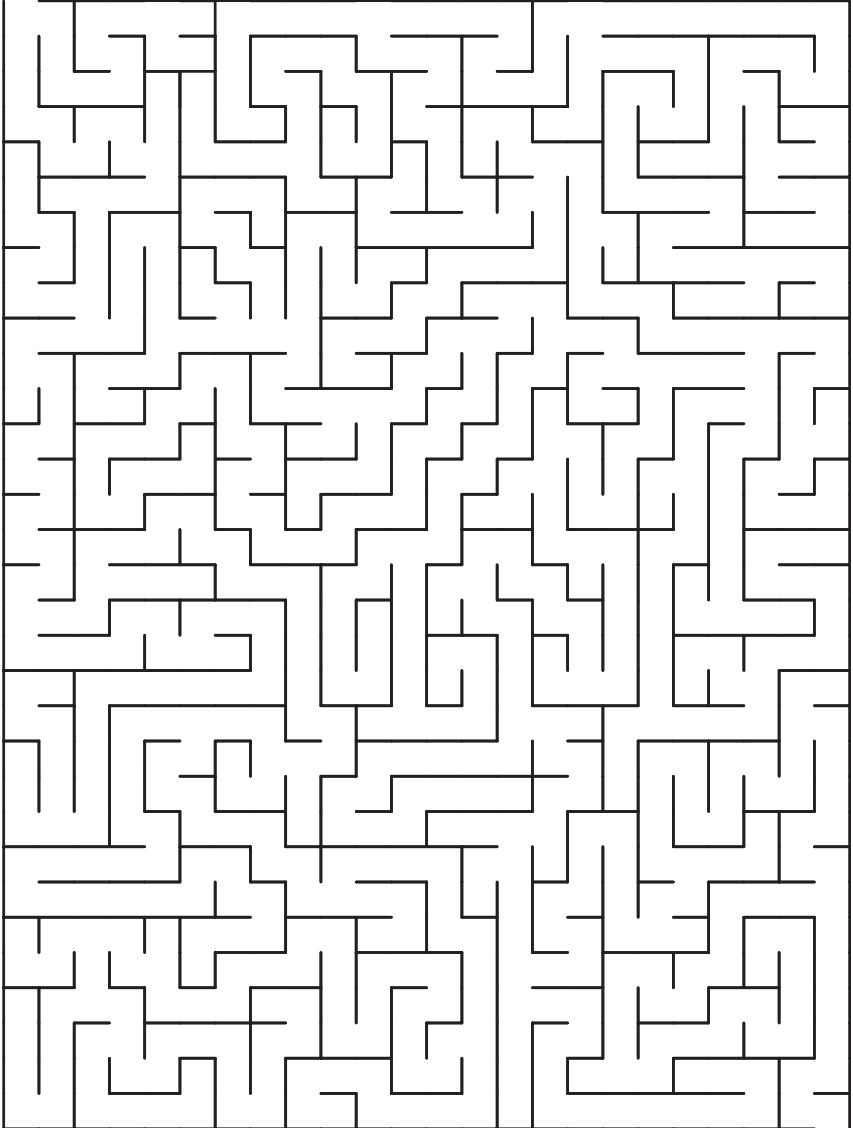

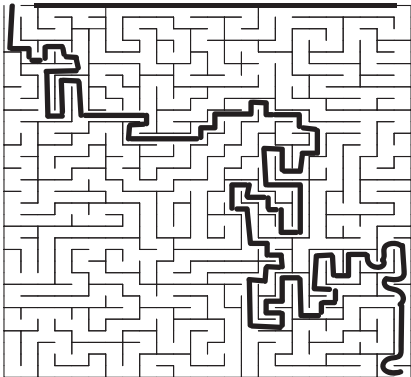
