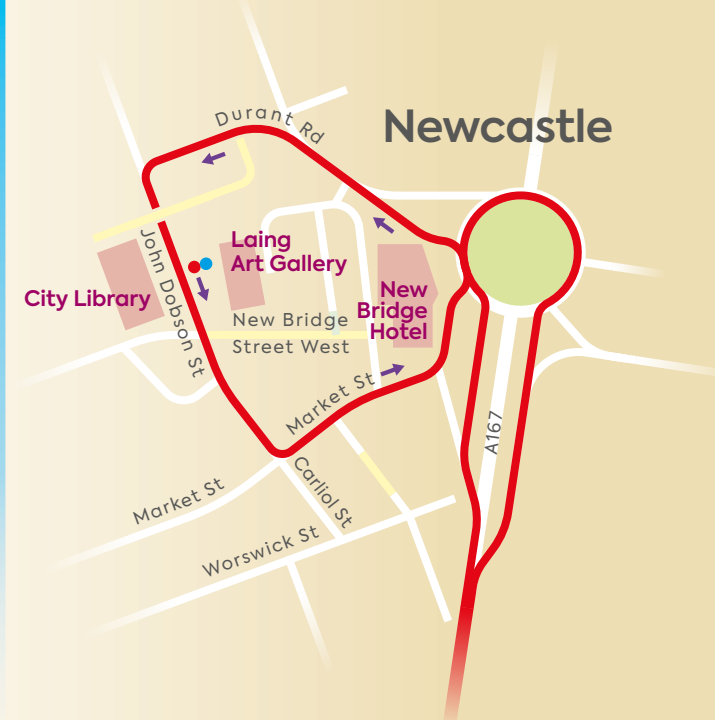

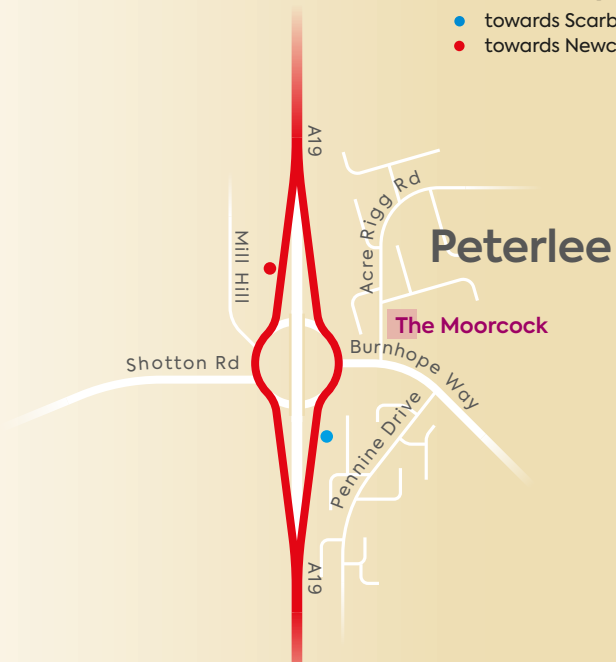

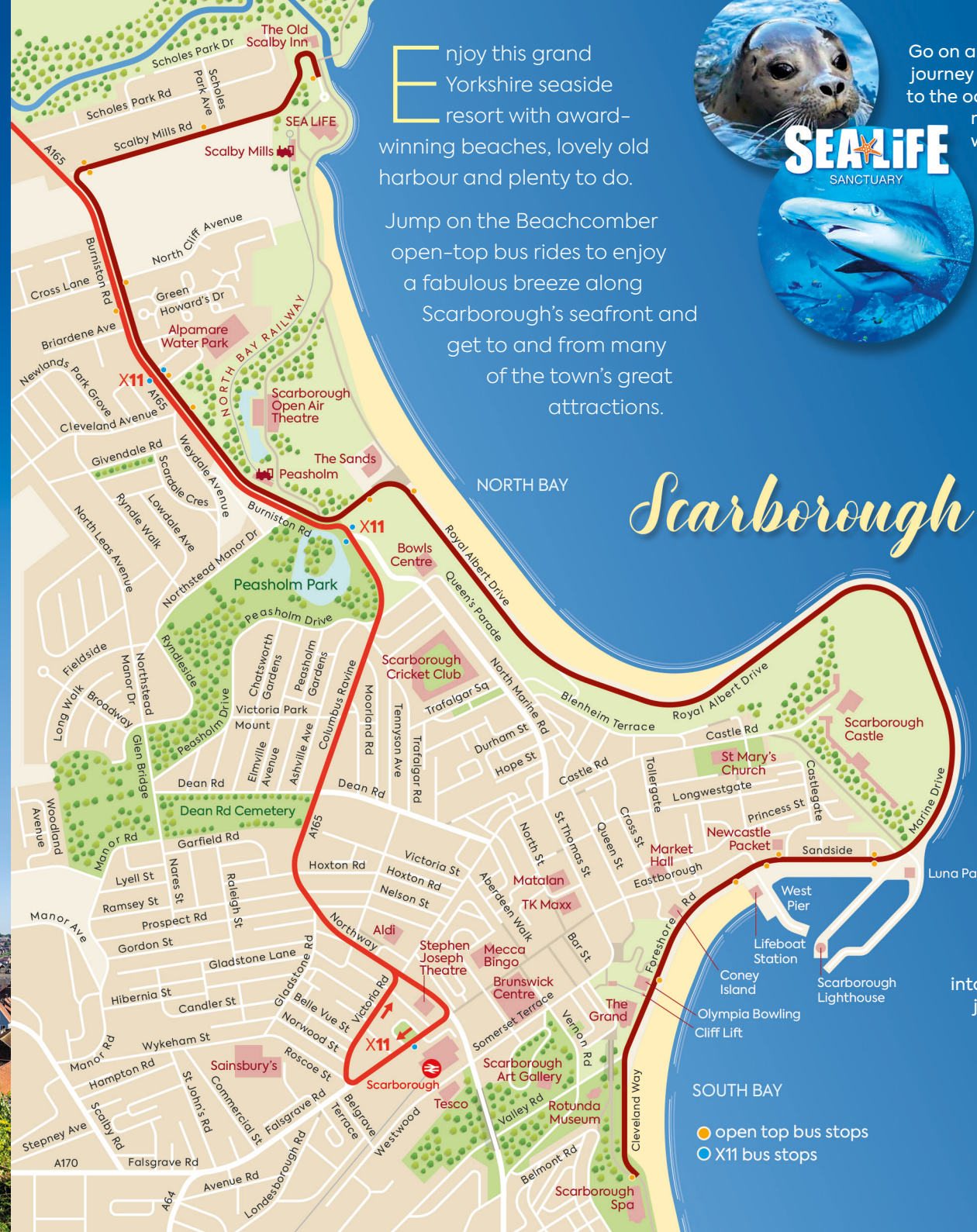
Whitby

this characterful fishing town.



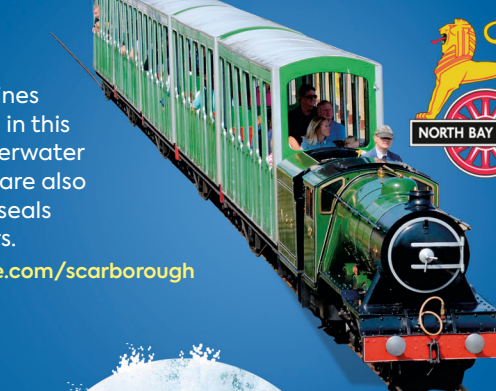
