OUR SIMPLE GUIDE

For the best tickets, live times and bus tracking download our app from the App Store and Google Play Store.

Get to the bus stop a few minutes before departure time and raise your arm to signal stop as the bus approaches.

Tell our friendly driver which ticket you want, and if you're 16 or over, remember you'll need to show ID to get our young persons discounts.

Buy your ticket in advance on our app or buy onboard from the driver. Try to pay with using contactless if you can.

Take a seat, enjoy the ride and press the bell when the bus gets close to where you want to get off.

how to get to your COVID-19 vaccine appointment



Whether your vaccine appointment is at one of the region's vaccination centres, hospital hubs or local vaccination clinics, getting there couldn't be easier with us.

We run a wide range of frequent buses across the region, including three shuttle bus services which have improved access to the Nightingale Hospital vaccination centre. We've introduced a dedicated bus stop outside the Centre for Life vaccination centre in Newcastle.

If you're a concessionary pass holder in Tyne and Wear or County Durham, you can also travel free before 9.30am if you have an appointment – all you need to do is show your letter, e-mail or text message with your pass when you board the bus.



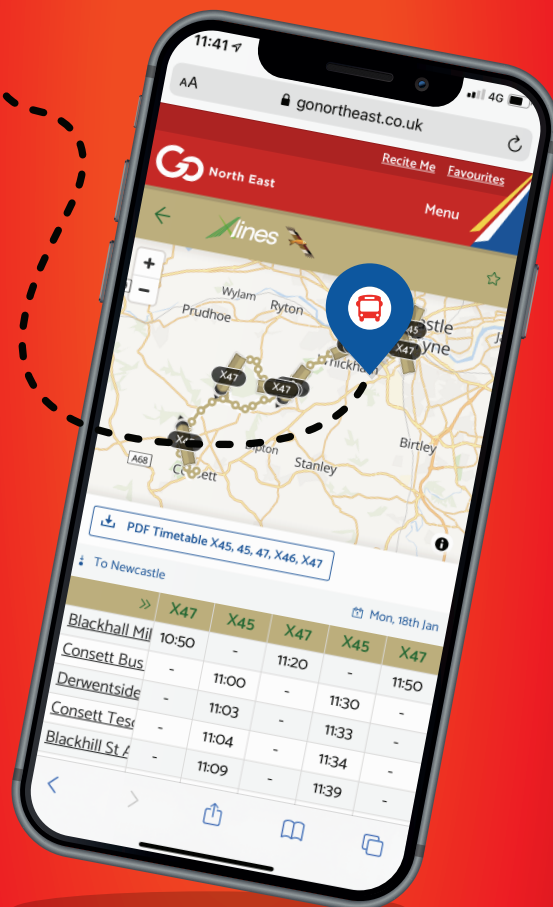
steps to help get you there

how to get to the **Nightingale Hospital** vaccination centre



We have three vaccination centre shuttle buses operating to Nightingale Hospital vaccination centre in Washington, providing great connections with local buses and the Tyne & Wear Metro. You can use your concessionary bus pass, day or weekly tickets on these buses, just scan your ticket as you usually would or you can pay for your journey on the bus. All buses accept contactless payments via card or Apple or Google Pay.

connector**shuttle**

ConnectorShuttle runs up to every 15 minutes from Concord, seven days a week, and connects with our Cityrider 56 and many other services, offering frequent connections from across the region.

METRO **M** shuttle

MetroShuttle runs up to every 15 minutes from Heworth Interchange, seven days a week, and provides a connection from the Tyne & Wear Metro, and other local bus services.

sunderland**shuttle**

SunderlandShuttle runs up to every 20 minutes, providing a direct link from Sunderland, Pallion, Hylton Retail Park and Castletown, seven days a week.

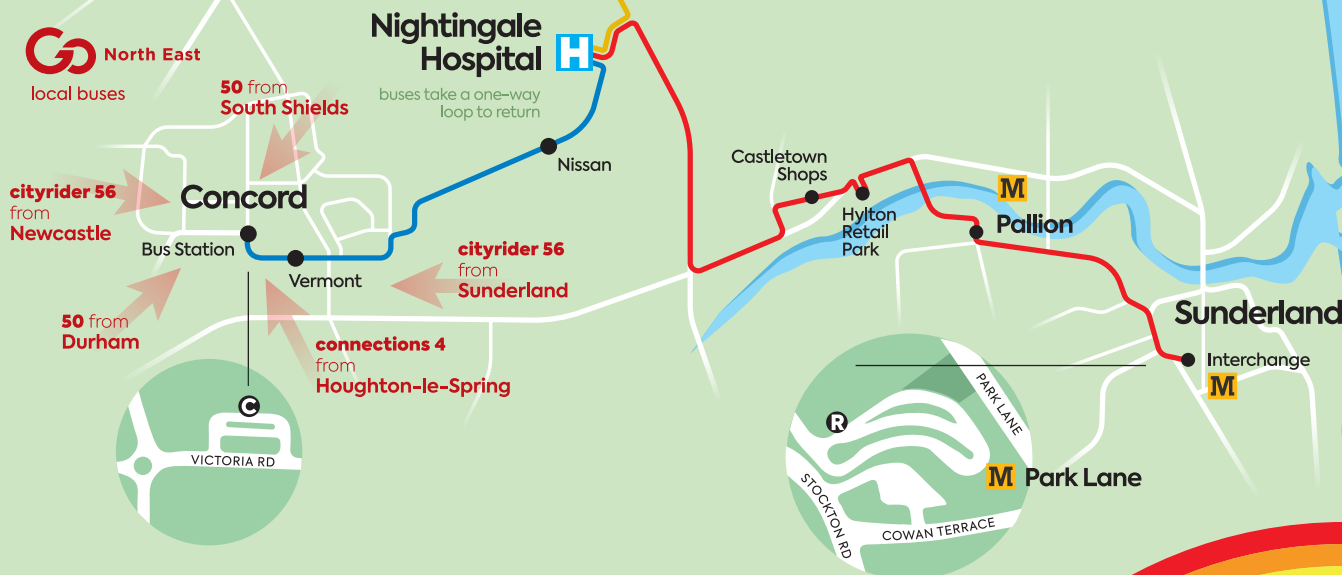

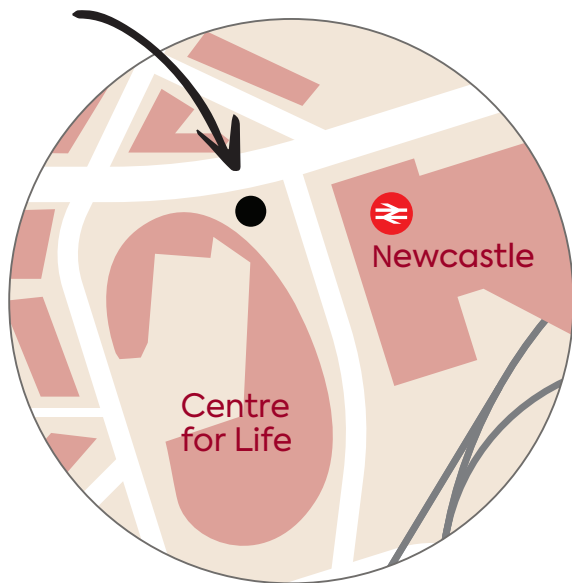
